The position summary describes current duties and responsibilities for which the employee will be held accountable and evaluated upon. General Description:

This is a part-time position requiring 30 hours per week. Shifts schedules to be determined. Must be available to fill in for other MC operators. Under general supervision of the Senior MC & Broadcast Tech, the MC & Broadcast Tech will perform routine technical support and master control duties. This position will handle the broadcast ops of the station including and not limited to the live and other broadcast ops.

Essential Functions:

Maintaining high standards of technical service will perform the following duties:

- Air Programs and Breaks in accordance with the station log and FCC guidelines.
- Operate station automation system.
- Control transmitters TX & RX and record faults and readings on the transmitter log.
- Record and time programs on tape and video server as determined by the recording schedule.
- Assists in Gallery operations and prepping

Duties & Accountabilities:

- Report equipment errors and discrepancies to supervisor.
- Troubleshooting station systems including broadcast equipment.
- Responsible for MC operations and workflows
- Assist with closed captioning of programs for air and web when needed.

- Part of studio operations and prepping
- Assists in cabling (Network, A/V, etc.)
- Monitor transmitters RX and TV, & record faults and readings on the transmitter log.
- Responsible for internal A/V network
- Responsible for maintenance checks on studio and broadcast chain
- Report equipment errors and discrepancies to engineering maintenance.
- Basic electronic maintenance skills.
- Record and time programs on tape and video server as determined by the recording schedule.

Competencies:

- Knowledge of Windows and Mac operating systems.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office
- Ability to read and follow program logs.
- Ability to interpret technical sheets and diagrams
- Ability to complete assignments in an unsupervised environment.
- Must have transportation available to accommodate flexible schedule.
- Ability to explain technical situations and to follow instructions given over the telephone.
- Cabling and wiring skills
- Basic A/V knowledge
- Ability to work flexible hours and anticipate on-call duties
- Broadcast trouble shooting skills
- Must be able to lift 50 lb
